Hobbs Drive Closure

The third segment of the Hobbs Drive closure is scheduled to commence the week of July 30, and extend into the following week of August 6-10.

Beginning Monday, July 30, 2018, Hobbs Drive will again be closed. When opened, motorists should use extreme caution as the manholes will be adjusted above the existing surface in preparation for the final layer of asphalt to be installed.

Beginning Tuesday, July 31, through Thursday, August 2, Hobbs Drive from Grant Street to Third Avenue will be restricted to one lane of traffic, regulated by flag control. Access to Greenhaven Lane and adjacent side streets will be maintained from Grant Street via Ferncliff Drive. The intersections of Greenhaven Lane and Hilton Drive will be completely closed to all traffic for the duration of these days. Motorists should anticipate significant delays lasting up to 20 minutes and are encouraged to seek alternate routes during this timeframe, if possible.

Signage, barricades, and traffic regulators will be present to guide traffic around the construction site.

The entire project is expected to be completed by August 10, unless weather or construction delays occur.
