CITY OF ALPENA GOOSE HUNT

The City of Alpena will conduct goose hunts during October 2008. Goose hunts will take place on Monday, October 20, 2008; and Friday, October 24, 2008.

Each day the hunt will begin one-half hour before sunrise and conclude at noon. Authorized hunting areas are the Wildlife Sanctuary and that portion of the Thunder Bay River commonly referred to as Besser Lake.

Portions of the City's Bi-Path will be closed during each hunt from approximately 6 a.m. to noon. The portions of the Bi-Path that will be closed are from Sytek Park to the main entrance of the County Fairgrounds.

In addition, these additional City properties will be closed during hunting hours: Gleason Park, corner of Washington Avenue and Eleventh Avenue; and Island Park.
