CHANGES IN LIFEGUARD STAFFING AT STARLITE BEACH

Due to an unavoidable loss of trained staff, the City of Alpena is advising the public that it will be operating with fewer lifeguards at Starlite Beach this season. The City is taking steps to maintain seven-day-per-week lifeguard patrols, and each patrol will continue to consist of two lifeguards.

However, due to the reduced staffing, situations could arise, as on Saturday, June 14, 2008, where no City lifeguards will be present at Starlite Beach. In such an event, the City will provide as much public notice as possible.

Visitors to Starlite Beach should take appropriate safety precautions and swimmers are advised that they swim at their own risk.
