NO PARKING – 3 A.M. TO 6 A.M. FROM NOVEMBER 1 THROUGH APRIL 1

The Alpena Police Department reminds City residents that vehicles cannot be parked on City streets between the hours of 3 a.m. and 6 a.m. from November 1 through April 1. This prohibition is necessary so that City streets can be thoroughly plowed during the winter months. Vehicles parked on a City street during the prohibited time period can be ticketed; and, if the vehicles interfere with snow plowing, those vehicles can be impounded at the owners' expense. Please help the City with its snow plowing efforts by not parking in the street during the prohibited time period. Overnight parking of vehicles in City lots is prohibited regardless of the time of year.

Police officers may allow citizens to park a vehicle on the street during this period if extenuating circumstances exist. Citizens who believe they have extenuating circumstances must contact the police department in advance. Unless the department grants permission to park on the street, the vehicle will be ticketed and possibly towed.
