City of Alpena Releases Survey for Recreation Plan Update

The City of Alpena, with assistance from the Northeast Michigan Council of Governments (NEMCOG), is updating its Recreation Plan.

A Recreation Plan contains plans for the future of all recreational facilities in the City and is required to be updated every five years. Communities are required to have a Department of Natural Resources (DNR) approved Recreation Plan in order to qualify for grant funding from the Michigan DNR.

The planning process incorporates a community participation element that encourages input from citizens. The City has chosen to gather this public input in an online survey. The survey takes approximately 5-10 minutes to complete and is available on the City website at www.alpena.mi.us or on the NEMCOG website at www.nemcog.org.
