**In the event of inclement weather, the fireworks display may be postponed and rescheduled for July 5. In the event of cancellation, the sites noted above will be notified, as well as the media.**

NOTE: Beginning at noon on Wednesday, July 3, 2019, and until the end of the fireworks show, the City will enforce an 800 foot safety perimeter around the fireworks site. The perimeter will be clearly marked. Citizens are asked to stay out of the marked off area for their own safety and to allow a safe working area for the fireworks company.
